- a 2-hour walking tour of 10 stops in the city centre taking you closer to the amazing personality of Liszt through visiting spots related to his life in Budapest followed by
- a 2-hour sommelier-led wine tasting event in the [Tasting Table wine bar](#) features a carefully curated selection of five (winter edition) or eight (summer edition) great Hungarian wines, among them the famous Tokaji Aszú. The event distils the wide range of Hungarian wine into a comprehensible story for you to get a good overview. Food pairings are served for each wine.

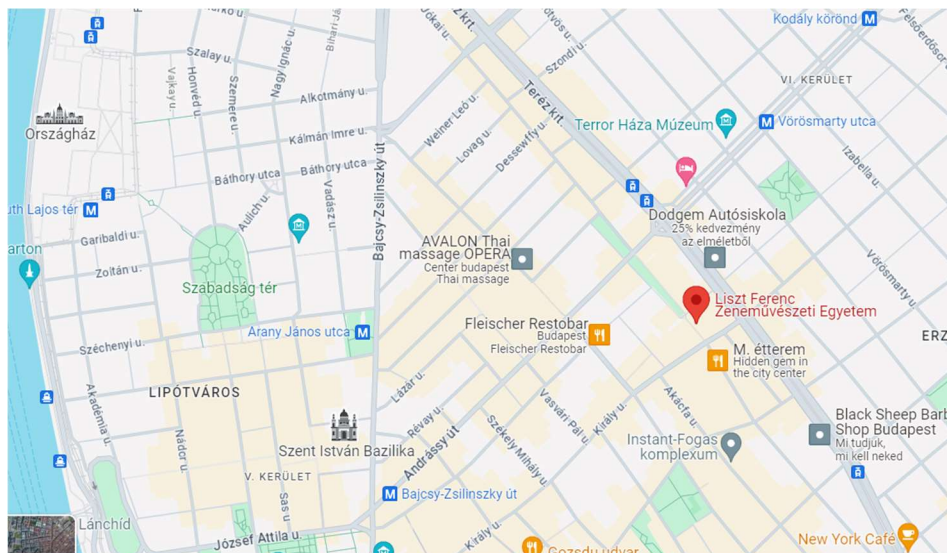
- **Fall/Winter edition (15 October - 31 March):** at 13.00 on selected Saturdays, please consult the Calendar for available dates.
It accommodates the “Wine, Cheese, & Charcuterie Tasting” with a selection of 5 different wines.
- **Spring/Summer edition (1 April – 14 October):** at 16.00 on selected Saturdays, please consult the Calendar for available dates.
It accommodates the “Essentials of Hungarian Wine” tasting exhibiting a selection of 8 different wines.

COST

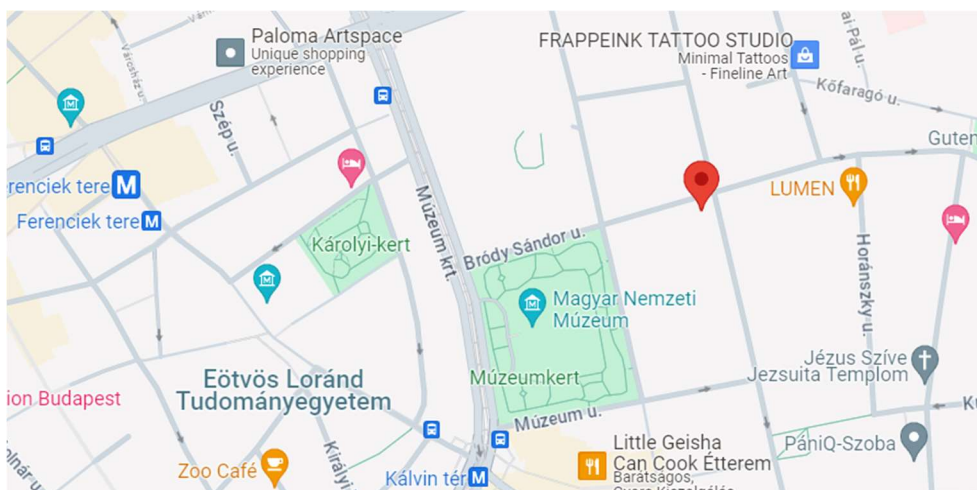


- by Tram Line 4, 6; – getting off at Király utca/Erzsébet körút stop
- by Trolleybus 70, 78 – getting off at Király utca/Erzsébet körút stop
- by Metro Line 1 (yellow), by Bus 105 – getting off at Oktogon station and take a short walk through Liszt tér to the upper end
- by foot consulting the city map
- by taxi

Advance booking is required. Please, note that owing to third-party obligations booking is closed 24 hours prior to the announced starting time.

INCLUDED/NOT INCLUDED

This is a walking tour where we stop in front of the musical memories' locations without internal visits. If you wish to visit and explore them later on your own, we will do our best to provide all necessary information to help you. Note, that this tour has a partial overlap with the Walking Tours Prelude and Andante in terms of the spots visited.

There is no live music experience during the tour, for concerts please, check the [concert venues'](#) websites. Our Facebook page, the [Read&Listen](#) chapter offers a large variety of music to listen and publications to read.

The cost of wine-tasting is included in the tour fee.

Getting to the meeting point must be arranged on your own.

A single metro ticket between two stops is included in the tour fee.

We provide a single-use headset free of charge.

For our guests with hearing aids, we provide an over-the-ear headphone free of charge.

TRAVEL

We use the lovely historic Millennial Underground; the oldest underground line in continental Europe for a short ride between Oktogon and Vörösmarty tér stations. The metro ticket is included in the tour fee. We walk for the rest of the tour.



NEEDED FOR THE WALK

Comfortable shoes, weather appropriate clothes including rain/wind/sun shade, umbrella, poncho, rain coat, skin protection, a bottle of water (the colour codes for bottled water in Hungary are as follows: pink cap - still, green cap - mildly carbonated, blue cap - sparkling).

Open mind and open heart☺.

Taking pictures is allowed, welcome and encouraged.

CHILDREN

We do not recommend the tour for children under 12 (unless they are exceptional musical talents), as the tour might be too tiring and lengthy for them, and the topic perhaps less than ideal for youngsters. However, if you decide to bring children under 12, please, understand that the guide has the right to ask you to leave the tour at any time should the behaviour of your children be considered to be detrimental to the enjoyment of the tour by other participants (see [Terms and Conditions](#)).

Minors (children under 18 in Hungary) must be accompanied by an adult and the law does not allow serving alcohol for them.

ACCESSIBILITY

Regretfully we need to say that this tour is not accessible for wheel-chair users, because the wine cellar cannot accommodate wheel-chairs.

For our guests with hearing aids we provide an over-the-ear headphone free of charge.

WEATHER

Budapest has continental climate, so during the winter some days might be very cold and very snowy (minus 5-10 Celsius (14-23 Fahrenheit) daytime; the summers can be quite hot (daytime rarely even 35-40 Celsius (95 -104 Fahrenheit) high).

The tour is cancelled or rescheduled under inclement weather conditions, which might hinder the full enjoyment of a walking tour. Such cancellations/rescheduling will be sent to each participant in writing to the e-mail address provided at the booking and will be displayed on the social media channels and on the website.
